LDCA Blazers Night a Success

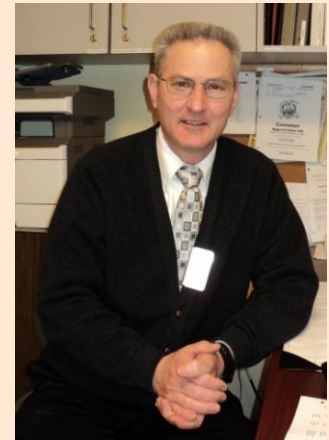

Ceasefire Oregon's Annual Gun Turn-In

The Ceasefire Oregon Education Foundation hosts an Annual Gun Turn-In to provide a place where gun owners can dispose of unwanted firearms. For each firearm turned in, residents receive a merchandise certificate. Advertising for this event, raises awareness of the risks and responsibilities of gun ownership, including the importance of safe storage.

The next gun turn-in will take place Saturday, April 9th, beginning at 10 a.m. Participants can take guns to the north side of Memorial Coliseum. The event will be staffed by Ceasefire Oregon Education Foundation volunteers and sworn officers from the Portland Police Bureau.

In the 16 successful years the event has been held, a total of 7, 303 guns have been collected. In 2009, no event was held due to lack of funding to purchase merchandise certificates. LDCA Public Safety Notes

This past few months have been relatively quiet with only a few car prowls and some drug activity on the Holladay Park MAX platform. 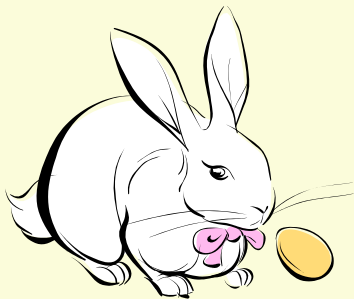
The Easter Bunny Arrives
