Portland Streetcar Construction

Please be advised that construction on the Broadway Bridge began the week of May 10th. Up to two lanes will be closed as crews prepare the bridge for the Streetcar. Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction. The bridge has a height limit of 12'0". Trucks and large vehicles must use

a detour. Work will occur on the bridge through June 30, 2011, with a full bridge closure July 6th – September 3rd.

Expect traffic delays on Lovejoy, Weidler and Broadway.

Sidewalk access will be maintained as much as

possible.

Public Safety Committee Update by Elaine Kemp

LDCA Public Safety members discussed steps being taken with gang related incidents at Holladay Park and Lloyd Center. The Police are now using a special interest file available to officers contacting individuals. The result has been the identification, arrest, and imprisonment of four gang leaders. A separate person is in custody on theft charges for two counties. Video taken by Lloyd Security and BPA have been vital to these efforts. If court issued "bench probation orders" are in

the special interest files, officers can more quickly enforce court orders. This works similar to the trespassing exclusions which have already proven successful. Violators can be arrested and detained which will likely be a major deterrent.

Security enhancement at Holladay Park is under review by Tri-Met and the Parks Department.

Suggestions include extension of the fence, more lighting, structural changes,

and removal of the old trolley shelter. One bus shelter has already been removed.

Tri-Met and Portland Schools are reviewing student transit pass policies and hope to incorporate stricter guidelines in 2011.

The flash mob activity on April 26th on Broadway between 12th and 17th is still under investigation.

Two scheduled parades were held downtown on May 1st, with no reported incidents.
